More than 60% of human pathogens are zoonotic in origin. Public health is the science of protecting and improving the health of people and their communities, and ID specialists have a key role to play in preventing and responding to infectious diseases. Infectious diseases are caused by microorganisms that can hijack the nutrients and cellular machinery in our bodies. Fortunately, our immune system and current therapies can keep us healthy. Diagnosis can improve the effectiveness of treatments and avoid long-term complications for the infected patient. Undiagnosed patients can unknowingly transmit the disease to others. Early diagnosis can help to prevent or stop an outbreak.

Annelids have radiated into a number of niches. Some are parasitic, notably the leeches and myzostomarians; others filter-feed or prey on other invertebrates.



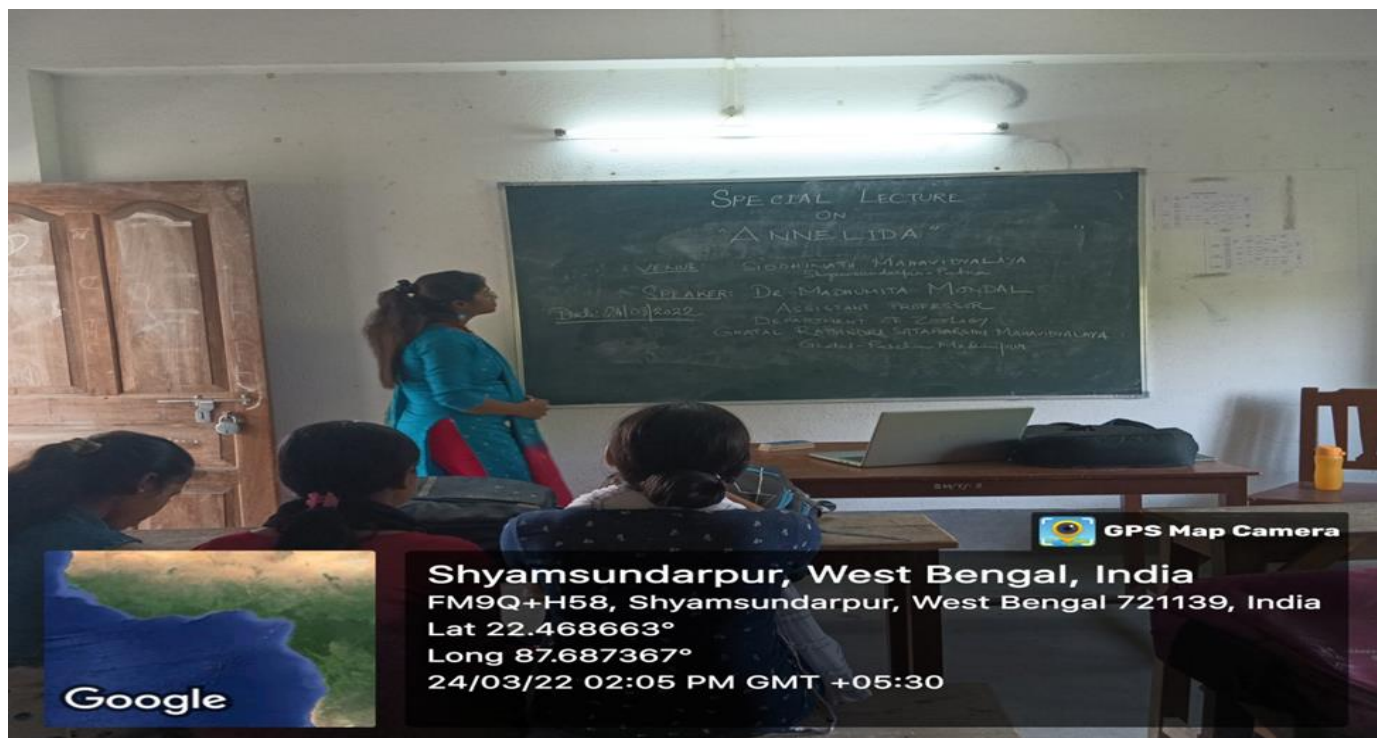

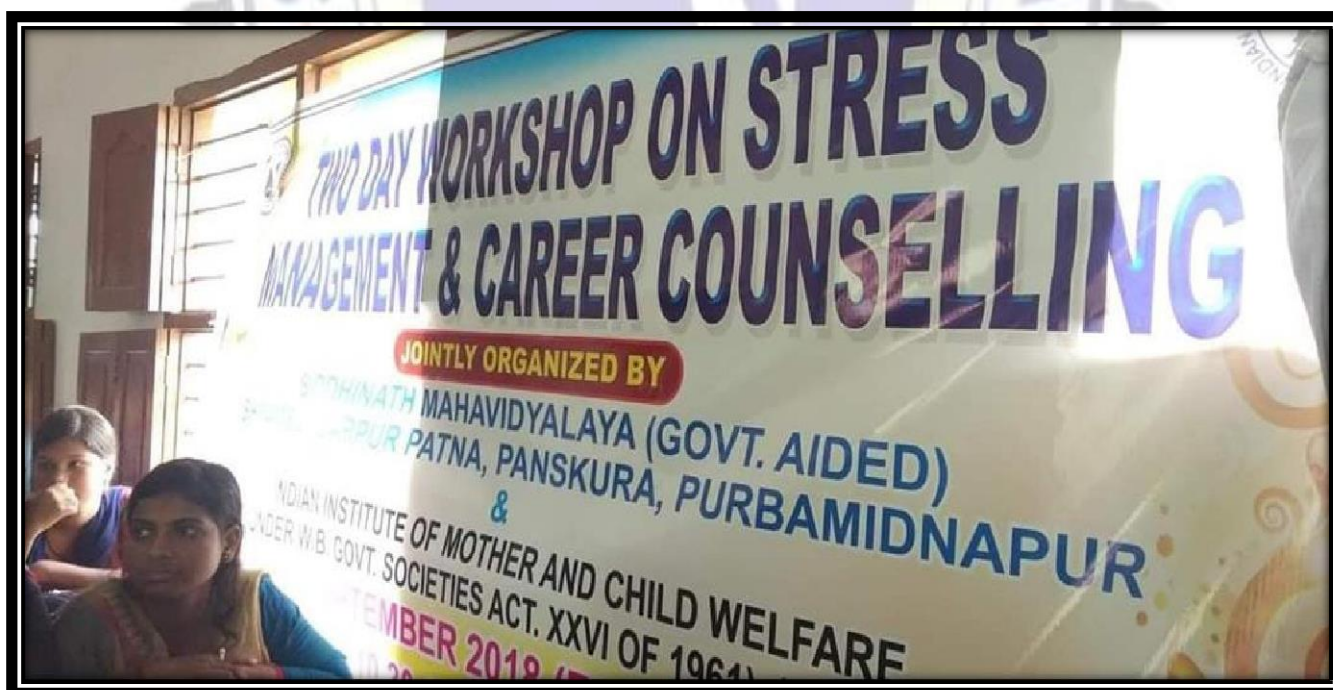
